

# Sample Chicago Scoring

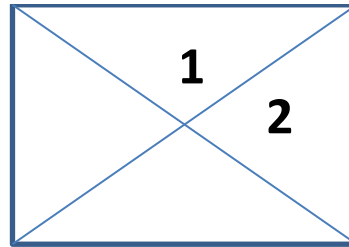
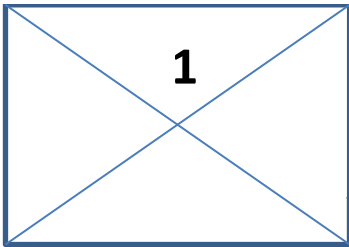

## Hand 1

Partner of Scorer draws high card and is first dealer. Scorer's team (We) bids and makes 4 Hearts. Since neither is vulnerable, the game adds a score of 300. Tricks are worth 120.

## Hand 2

"They" bid four hearts, but go down two tricks. Since they dealt, they are vulnerable and thus the two undertricks are worth 100 points each.

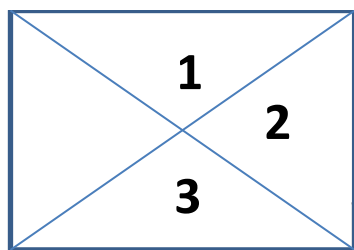

### Hand 3

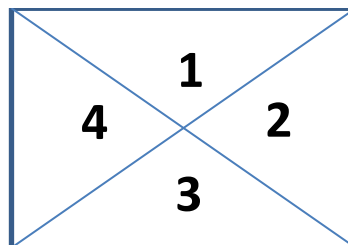
“We” bid three hearts, and make four.  
 Since it was a partial game, only 50 points of bonus plus 30 for the overtrick are included above the line, with 90 from the tricks as bid.  
 Vulnerability not a factor

### Hand 4

“They” bid three clubs and are doubled. They make it with an overtrick. Trick scores are doubled so there is 120 below the line. The bonuses include 500 for a vulnerable game, 200 for the doubled vulnerable overtrick, and 50 for “insult”
